HOW TO USE ON MOBILE (FREE):

My presets work on iOS and Android, you just need to install the free Lightroom App from the Apple Store or Google Play Store. Once you've installed it, head to the next step.

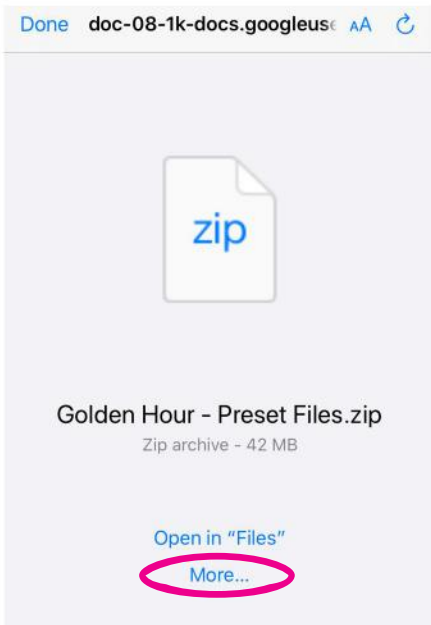
QUICK TIP: If you have the Lightroom CC Desktop Program and a Creative Cloud Subscription, you can simply copy the preset files to your preset folder on your desktop computer and they will automatically sync to your mobile!

DOWNLOAD THE ZIP TO YOUR PHONE

Our presets will come as DNG files that you can download directly to your phone. When you download the .ZIP you'll need to extract this on your phone.

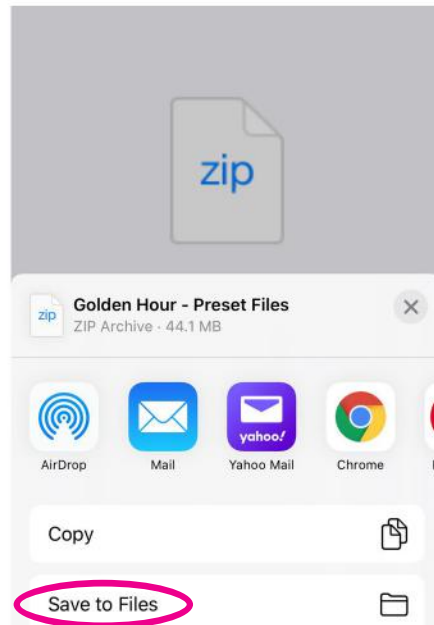
You'll find the download link in your purchase email, find this and tap 'Download' then follow the step by step guide below.

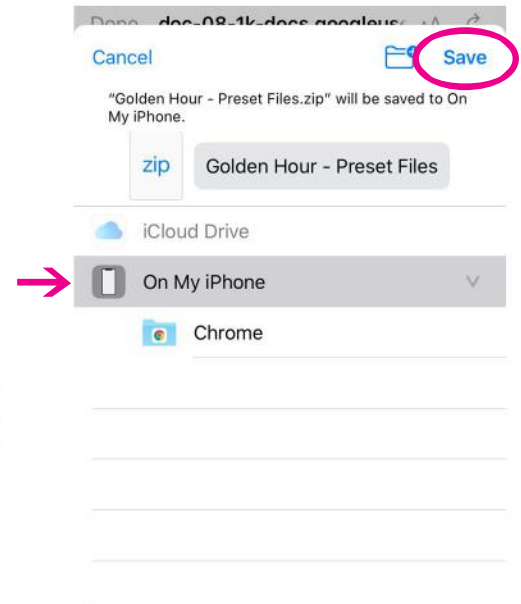
When prompted, tap 'More..'

Tap 'Save to Files'

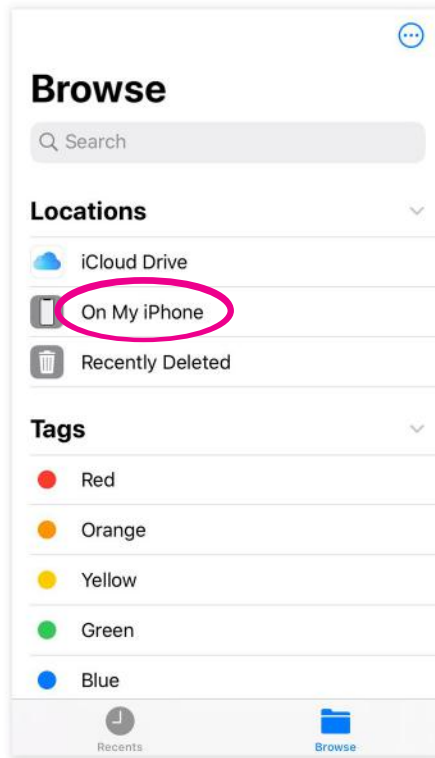
Tap 'On My iPhone' - Then 'Save'

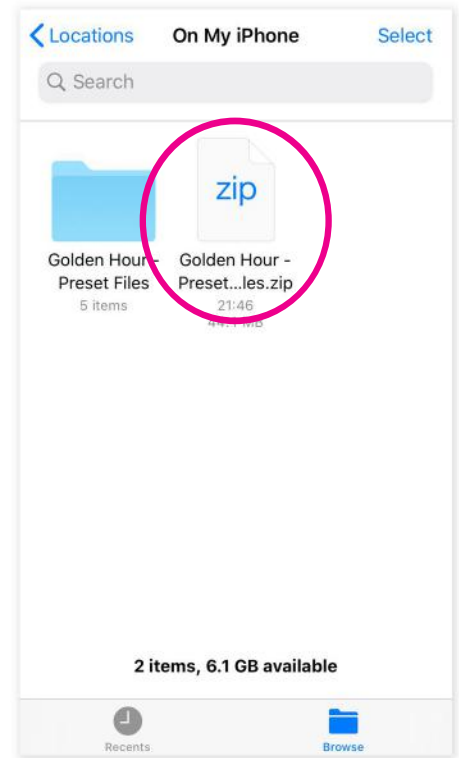
Now, Open 'Files' on your iPhone

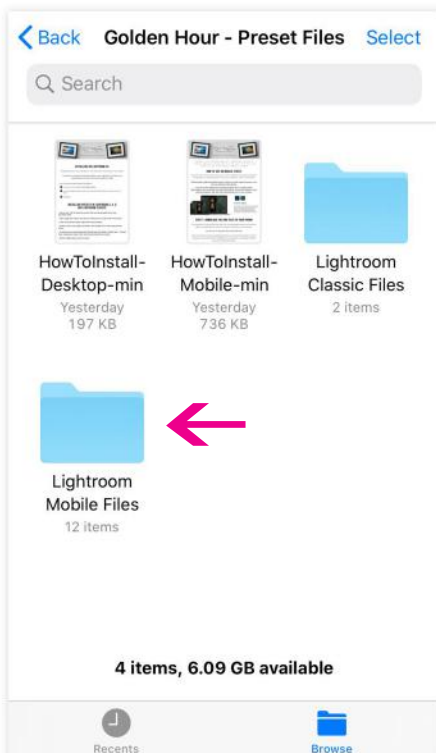
Tap 'On My iPhone'

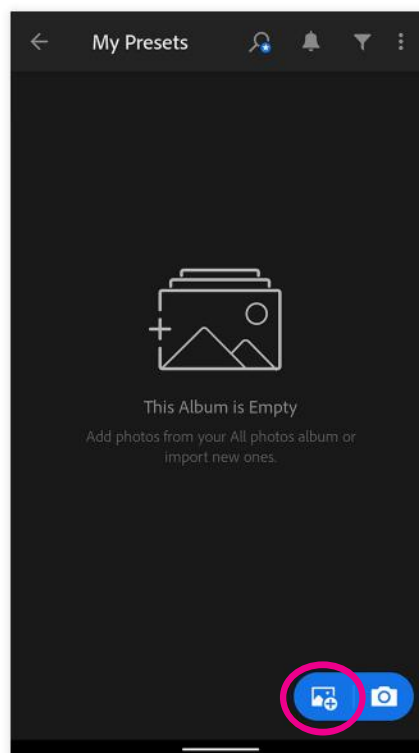
Tap the .ZIP file and it will extract to a folder.

7.



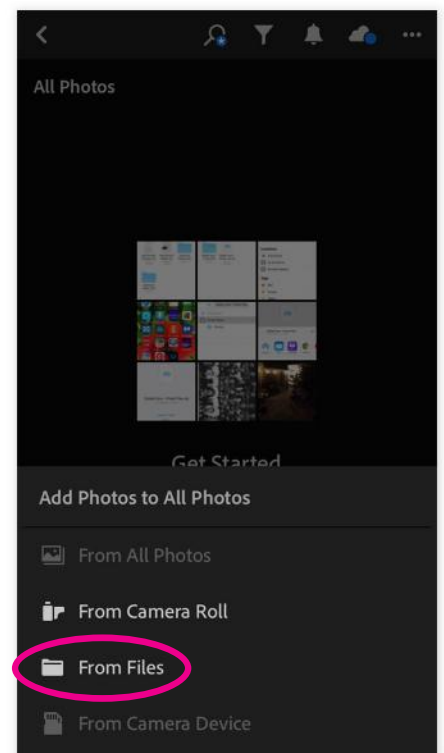
The files you need are in this folder. The other folder is for the desktop version of Lightroom CC.

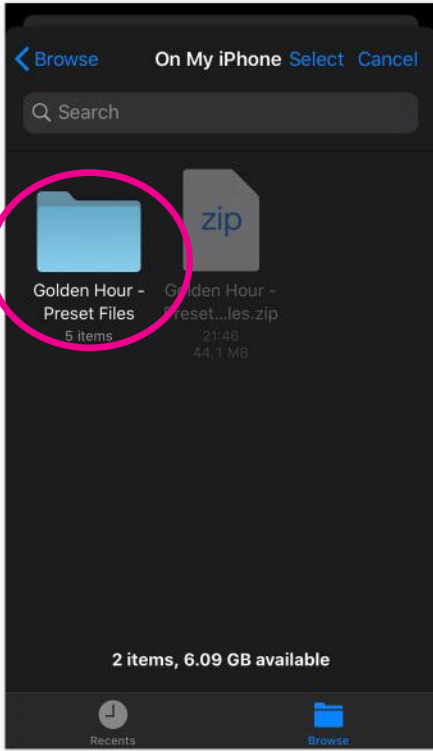
Head into the Lightroom App. Create an account if prompted, then tap the Add Photos button.

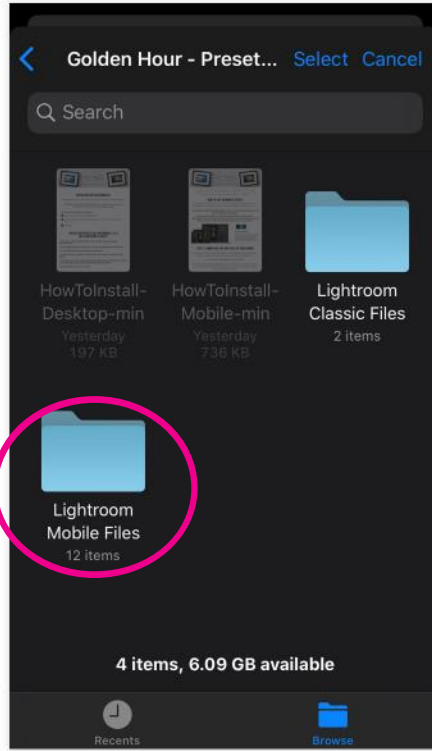
Tap 'From Files'. This will open up your files.

10.



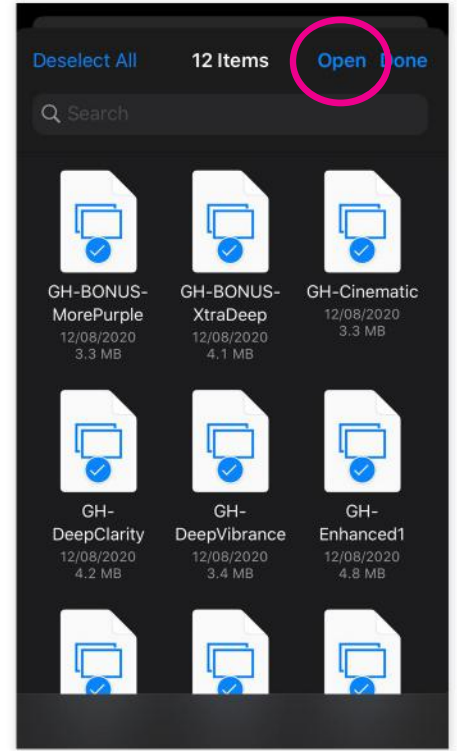
Choose the preset folder you just extracted.

Tap 'Lightroom Mobile Files'

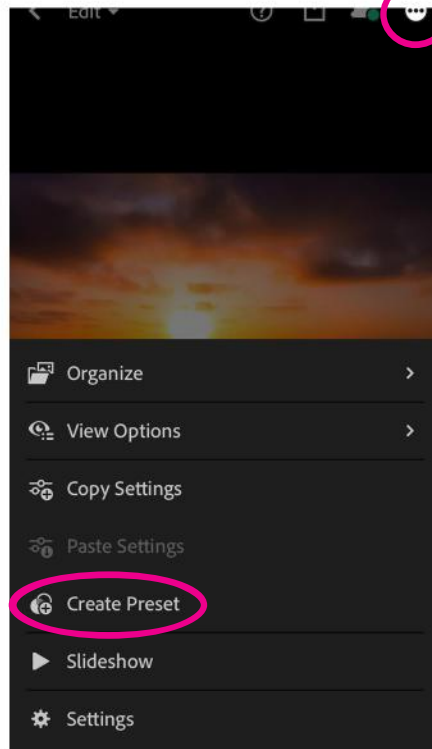
Select All Files (Tap Select at the top right, then tap each file) Then tap 'Open'

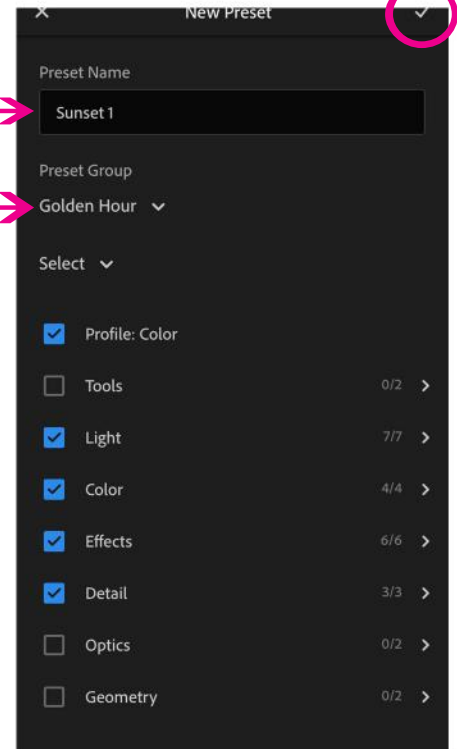
Now to save the preset from each image. Open the first image.

Tap the 3 dots in the upper right hand corner. Then tap 'Create Preset'

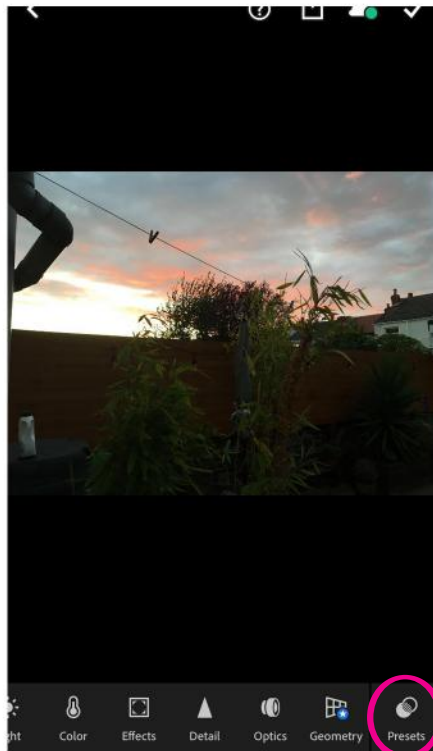
Give your Preset a name, ie. Sunset 1. You can add it to a new group if you wish to keep things organised. Ensure all are ticked except Tools, Optics and Geometry. Tap the Tick to complete.

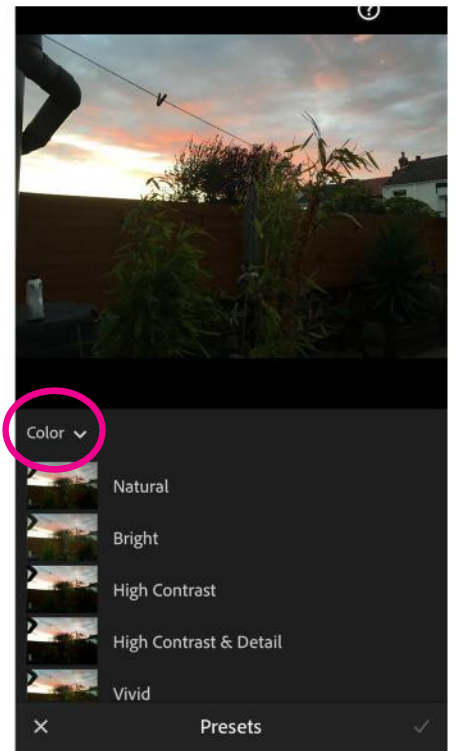


Repeat the previous step for all 12 images. Give each preset a name and add it to the same group if you wish.

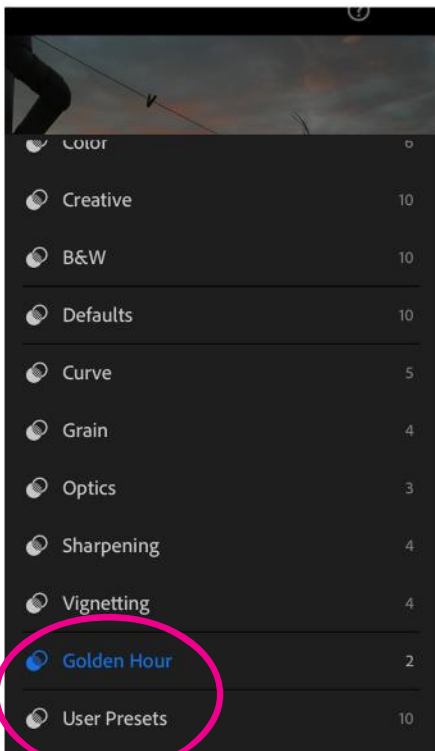
Install Complete!



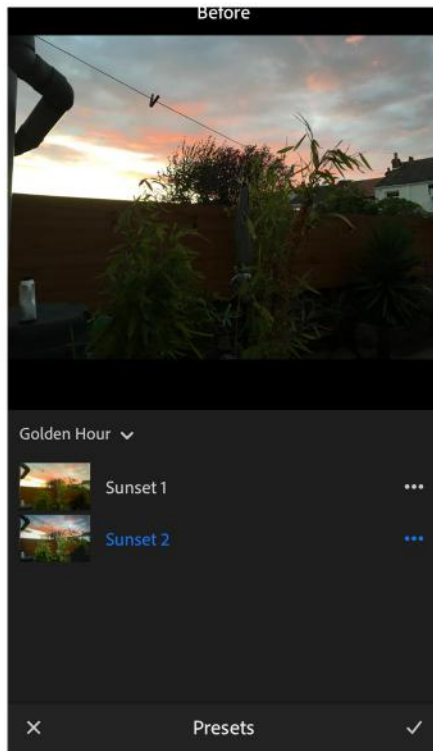
That's all! Now when you open your own photo, click 'Presets' to find your new items.

Choose the group you saved your presets to. It may be in User Groups if you didn't add them to a group.
